The support for our Wadawurrung team not only provides employment opportunities but also serves as a vehicle for mentoring and capacity building within the Wadawurrung community, strengthening their ties to the land and their cultural identity.

Wadawurrung Indigenous Plant Nursery

Our plant nursery is located at Ballan on a Wadawurrung-owned property near the Bostock Reservoir.

Established in 2022, it offers quality indigenous plants grown to order. On Country seed collection, provenance and health are the corner stones of our plant production. Our team work to the six seasons of Wadawurrung Country harvesting seed at its best, ensuring vigorous and robust propagation results.

Bushtucker and Specialist plants (refer to list) These are priced higher due to cultural significance, the level of difficulty to propagate and limited seed availability (e.g. listed as endangered)	\$3.90 per tubestock
All other plants	\$3.50 per tubestock
Hiko (grasses only)	\$1.50 per cell (must order minimum of 40) *\$60 per tray of 40
5cm round pots and cuttings	\$4.00 per pot
14cm pots (select species)	\$9.90 per pot

Review and recommendation of existing planting list	\$200
Additional site visit and admin time	\$90 p/hr
Delivery fee	\$120 p/hr
Tubestock pot cleaning fee (sustainability is at the core of our production ethos)	\$3.00 per 50 plants ordered

All prices are exclusive of GST.

- Orders for 2025 planting season (June – October) must be placed by the 31st of October 2024
- A purchase order number is to be supplied to confirm your order. Orders will be invoiced 50% upfront, with the remainder being charged at delivery/planting.

Cancellation policy: if an order is withdrawn, the deposit portion will not be refunded.



Wadawurrung Field Services

The field services team is comprised of Traditional Owners and experienced conservation and land management staff from across Wadawurrung Country.

With depots at Ballan and Breamlea, Wadawurrung is well placed to service all of Wadawurrung Country. Our team is growing, to ensuring practical Gobata Dja (Caring for Country) outcomes.

Knapsack spraying (incl. chem cost)	\$105/hr

Truck, tractor and mowing	\$120/hr
Rabbit control (phosphine tablets, cost incl.)	\$100/hr
Tree guards, stakes, jute mesh, rabbit proof fencing material	To be quoted based on the job
